

#### Edit Model Bar 3.0 Block




- This is the main screen that appears when editing the homepage block containing the model bar or changing the block type to "Model Bar 3.0"
- Select bulk actions to modify start/expiration dates, delete model bar items, change the pricing format used (ex. change MSRP to Internet Price), or clone/move selected items to another tab
- Users can add tabs along the top, corresponding to model bar categories (e.g. OEMs, "Popular", "Sedans", "Performance", "Crossovers and SUVs")
  - o Tab settings & preferences can be configured by clicking "Tab Settings"
- Like in ESM, basic information can be edited from this screen [start/expiration dates (if applicable); custom links; model bar item titles; model bar images (opens Media Gallery slideout)]
- User can re-order items, edit, show/hide, and delete individual items
- Additional options to populate model bar from OEM default, fill from virtual inventory, or add items.

#### Edit Model Bar 3.0 Block – Edit Tab Settings




- "Tab Settings" button triggers slideout with additional options
- Allows user to configure additional options for the tab:
  - Tab name
  - Default thumbnail link for all content within the tab (defaults to /searchnew.aspx)
  - o Display the tab as text, an image (e.g. an OEM logo), or image w/ text underneath
    - If image is selected, option appears to select a tab image via a Media Gallery slideout and apply alt text
  - o Disable the current tab or set it to display as the default (open) tab when a user first views the homepage
  - Set conditions for tab appearance (e.g., only show "Commercial" tab if there are commercial vehicles in stock)
  - Set tab start/expiration dates

#### Edit Model Bar 3.0 Block – Re-Order Tabs




- Users can click-and-drag to re-order tabs
- Includes option to auto-fill tab content based on Symphony specials
- Allow Role 1/Design users to set the current model bar configuration as the default for a particular OEM/template (same as Model Bar 2.0)
  - o Other user roles will instead see an option to replace the current model bar with the OEM default
  - o Both actions should require user confirmation before applying the default

## Add/Edit Items – Add a Model Bar Item (Image)




- Screen appears when user clicks the "Add Item" button on the "Edit Model Bar 3.0" block (appears on page 1)
- User can choose to set type as "Image" or "Model"
  - "Image" is the equivalent of a custom button in Model Bar 2.0
  - "Model" will populate the same information shown on page
- Check one or more tabs for where to display the model
- Set model DQL filter for inventory [uses default thumbnail link set in Edit Tab Settings (per page 2) + the DQL string, e.g. /searchnew.aspx?model=Malibu]
  - These can also apply to Conditions
- Set a specific custom link to override the default link. Include options:
  - Open in new tab
  - Only use link if no models are in stock
- Set conditions with custom logic (e.g. for Toyota, hide Mirai if the dealer is not located in California), start/expiration dates, and inventory conditions
- Allow user to set:
  - Image
  - Title
  - Subtitle
  - Value & value disclaimer
  - 1-2 CTAs
  - Tag/Disclaimer
- Allow user to cancel, save, & checkbox to "save and add another"

### Add/Edit Items – Edit a Model Bar Item (Model)




- Same as Model Bar 2.0, allow user to enter Year, Make, Model
- Permit user to customize DQL
- If custom thumbnail link is entered, override the default thumbnail link
  - Allow user to indicate if this should only override if DQL filter = 0
- Users can edit the following content:
  - Image
  - Model title (defaults to just the model name)
  - City/Hwy MPG, MPG title (e.g. "est. MPG"), and MPG disclaimer MPG is autopopulated based on YMM chosen
  - Price to display (MSRP, Internet/Final Price, custom price, or lease/finance information populated by APEX)
  - Price disclaimer

### Settings – Model Bar Layout – Slick




- Allows user to configure layout and display settings for the entire model bar
- Permits desktop/tablet/mobile configuration
- Preview pane on right side gives an approximation of the feature being edited to demonstrate differences between:
  - Model bar styles
  - Arrow and tab formats
  - Models shown per row

# Settings – Model Bar Layout – Classic




The "Classic" style generates the Model Bar 2.0 layout, but with the ability to show the model bar on mobile and integrate tabs.

## Settings – Headings and Content



- Allows user to add title & sub-title (text field) and custom HTML content above and below the model bar
- Users can add 1-2 CTAs
- Right side shows basic preview of how the content displays in the context of the model bar

# Settings – Item Display



- Like the Specials UI, adjust how all model bar items display:
  - Set colors, font size, borders, and margins/padding
  - Show/hide
  - Re-order information
  - Reset styling or display to default
- In the Image settings, set a default model color (if possible) and thumbnail image angle
